Roger and his wife Sue, also of the group, were high school sweethearts and have been married since July 1979. Roger grew up on bluegrass and country music. His dad, who could

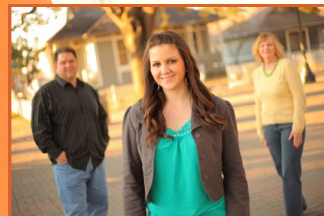
